Community Workshop on Artificial Intelligence in Education

Introduction

With the potential to tackle some of the most pressing challenges in education today and revolutionise teaching and learning practices, artificial intelligence (AI) holds tremendous promises. Following the activities of its squad “AI in education”, the European Digital Education Hub (EDEH) now announces a workshop on this topic to be held in Bucharest, Romania, on June 29 and 30, 2023. Education professionals from all sectors are invited to **apply by April 30, 2023**.

Theme

A wide range of topics can be found at the intersection of AI and education, such as the use of AI in adaptive learning and personalisation; its role in assessment and evaluation; ethical considerations related to AI and of course innovative approaches to curriculum design and teaching using AI. It is key for education professionals to build skills and knowledge on these topics to be able to apply them in real-world projects and initiatives.

The EDEH workshop on AI in education will revolve around how to incorporate AI responsibly and effectively into educational practices. Additionally, interactive sessions will focus on fostering new collaborations among participants to further advance the use of AI in education.

Why Attend

The workshop offers an excellent opportunity to stay current and connect with 30 international professionals who share an interest in AI in education. Opportunities to share expertise and building relationships that can lead to future collaborations are an integral part of the agenda of this 1,5-day event.

Practical Details

Arrival in Bucharest is expected for the afternoon/evening of Wednesday, June 28, departure in the evening of Friday, June 30.

All costs for accommodation and subsistence will be covered for selected participants (the organisers will book this directly). Travel costs within Europe will be 100% reimbursed as well, upon presentation of receipts, boarding passes, etc. Selected participants should book travel themselves, **once their participation has been confirmed**. The workshop is limited to 30 participants. Please note that you need to work in an Erasmus+ programme country in order to apply¹.

Profile of Participants

Participants have demonstrated knowledge on the broader topic of AI in education, understand the issues related to AI in education and are able to demonstrate their insights with examples in the application form. They may come from all education sectors, policymaking, workplace learning & training, EdTech or the private sector, and may be involved in projects on the topic.
